Summary of Guest Speaker Cindy Bruecks, San Diego Master Gardener

TOPIC: Make your Garden and Home More Fire Safe (see handout for more details)

Follow checklist on hand out: note websites

We now have mega fires and mega winds.

Make sure you have pre planned an evacuation route for you and your pets.

Fire season is all year.

3 ways fire can spread:

- 1- Embers, sparks can fly easily
- 2- Gutters- dried material inside
- 3- Radiant heat: hot material can burn from 8 ft away.

Leave roots in soil when removing dried plants to prevent erosion in case of rain,

Mulch sparse vegetation. Don't use rubber mulch, it burns. Use Gorilla hair Mulch

Don't plant barrel cacti, it punctures fireman suits.

Remove all dead plants from the garden and lawn.

## Ready the House:

- Clean all debris on roof and landscape
- Adjust house for amber denial
- Clean gutters use metal screen over dual pane windows
- Add you mobile phone# and get the app for www.readysandiego.org and
   WATCHDUTY by the county from CalFire.

## **CONCLUSIONS:**

- Review your landscape lot for resistance to fire.
- Review your family's overall fire readiness.
- Harden your home against airborne ember incursion.
